**ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT  
to  
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
WE CARE MANATEE, INC.**

**ARTICLE III. PURPOSE**

This corporation is organized exclusively for the sole purpose of providing health care services on a volunteer basis through its members each of whom are duly licensed physicians.

- A. The purpose for which this organization is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue law.
- B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- C. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
