Article of incorporation of the undersigned, desiring to form a non-profit missionary magazine corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of chapter 617, Florida Statutes, do hereby certify:

**ARTICLE 1. NAME**

The name of the Corporation is Bridge to Life Missionary Magazine, Inc.

**ARTICLE 2. DURATION**

The Duration of the Corporation is Perpetual.

**ARTICLE 3. PLACE OF BUSINESS**

The principal office of the Corporation is 27032 S. Dixie Hwy. Naranja Plaza, Naranja Florida 33032

**ARTICLE 4. PURPOSE (S)**

The purpose(s) of the Corporation Bridge to Life Missionary Magazine is as follows:

This Corporation is a non-profit Missionary Magazine, organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, exclusively to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ, it is not organized for the private gain of any person.

The purpose of this Corporation, Bridge to Life Missionary Magazine is to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. Bridging the gap between humanity and God. Spreading ray's of hope to the depressed, encouraging reader's to persevere through their daily trials and tribulations. To educate those who thirst for knowledge of God's Word and opening doors for spiritual growth.

The purpose of this Corporation, Bridge to Life Missionary Magazine is to engage in any and all lawful business purpose(s) in the United State of America upon non-profit corporations.

**ARTICLE 5. CORPORATION DISSOLUTION**

The purpose of this Corporation, Bridge to Life Missionary Magazine is not for a private gain. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered. To make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda. Otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not Participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any part of these articles. This Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to carry on. (a) By a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal income tax code. (b.) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code. The Corporation Distribution of Assets, upon the dissolution or winding up of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of the corporation, shall be distributed equally among. **Power From On High Ministries, Inc. and Anointed Christian Faith Center, Inc.** Which is organized and operated exclusively for religious, and charitable purposes, and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

**ARTICLE 6. MEMBERS**

The Corporation shall have voting members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The bylaws may provide for non-voting members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges
