**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FLORIDA MARINE YOUTH INSTITUTE, INC.**

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TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Florida Marine Youth Institute, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under Section 501(c)3.

ARTICLE III - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation will exist perpetually.

ARTICLE IV - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The address of the initial register office is 16019 Eagle River Way, Tampa, Florida 33624 and the name of the initial registered agent is Victor Young located at the initial address. The registered office may be moved from time to time by action of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The business of this corporation shall be conducted by the Board of Directors. This corporation shall have a minimum of three directors and no more than five directors on its Board of Directors. Each officer and director shall hold office until his or her successor shall be found. The duties and powers and functions of the officers and Board of Directors shall be as usually devolved upon such officers and directors, unless otherwise provided by the By-Laws. The directors shall be elected as stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI - ORIGINAL DIRECTORS

ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VIII - SPECIAL PROVISIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Sections 501(c)3 purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate in public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code or (b) by a corporations contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)2 of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax act.

ARTICLE IX - DEDICATION OF CORPORATION ASSETS

Upon dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the undersigned, being the original subscriber to these articles hereinabove named, for the purpose of forming a corporation to do business, both within and without the State of Florida, and in pursuance of the general laws of the State of Florida, do make and file this Certificate of Incorporation, hereby declaring and certifying that the facts herein stated are true.

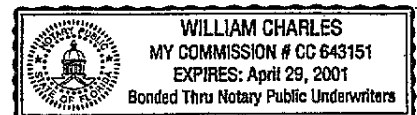


