Articles of Incorporation
Of

HEART TO HEART MINISTRIES, Inc.

We, the undersigned persons, constituting all the present members of this corporation not for profit with no new members having been admitted, do hereby, as of this 3rd day of 1999, adopt the following as our Articles of Incorporation to be filed and approved by the Secretary of the State of Florida.

Article I

The name of this organization not for profit shall be *HEART TO HEART MINISTRIES*, *Inc.*, (hereafter referred to as the "MINISTRIES").

Article II

The general nature and purpose of this corporation is to engage in religious, charitable, educational and other similar purposes, to wit:

- 1. To advance the Kingdom of God, by calling young people to faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and to increasingly reflect his character, ethics and compassion, at home, school and in society.
- 2. To own, hold in trust, use or otherwise possess, sell, convey, mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of such property, real or chattel, as may be needed for the prosecution of its work;
- 3. To establish such departments as may be necessary for the ministering of the gospel and the support of missionary activity at home and abroad;
- 4. To equip churches, their families, and young people to stand for moral excellence, to stand against moral compromise and existential and to avoid the dangers and costs of sinful habits of the heart;
- 5. To assist, encourage, and help network churches and other charitable religious and educational organizations in the conduct of similar activities.

The general nature and purpose of the corporation shall also include the following:

- 1. To receive, administer, disburse and invest gifts, devises and bequests by or from any persons or corporations, and acquire, enjoy, utilize or dispose of such property as may seem proper, with the further right to make donations for the public welfare or lend money for its corporate purposes and to re-invest its funds.
- To make contracts and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may deem appropriate, purpose bonds and other obligations and secure any of its obligations by mortgage and pledge of all or any of its properties, franchises or income, to issue bonds, notes, debentures or evidence of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage deed of trust or other security for the payment of funds so lent or invested.
- 3. To do any and all matters and things set forth in the Florida Statues which may be done by any corporation not for profit organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

Article III

This Corporation shall exist perpetually
