ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation (which is hereafter referred to as the "Corporation") shall be THE KOREAN SENIOR CENTER OF CENTRAL FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation shall be:

800 N. Ferncreek Avenue, Suite 16
Orlando, Florida 32803

ARTICLE III. PURPOSES

The specific and exclusive purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- (a) To provide its members and other senior citizens of central Florida with educational programs and activities, and to promote social intercourse among them;
- (b) To provide cultural and bi-lingual programs and activities for its members and their descendants, and to preserve Korean culture and language among the Korean American community in central Florida;
- (c) To provide voluntary service and monetary support for medical care among its members and other senior citizens in need in central Florida;
- (d) To promote and foster mutual understanding and good will among the peoples of all ancestry;
- (e) To acquire and maintain facilities for a community center to serve the Korean senior citizens in central Florida by engaging all types of activities not prohibited by law that will promote better citizenship among its members;

ARTICLE IV. INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND STREET ADDRESS

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP

The authorized number, qualifications, admission, voting and other rights and membership dues shall be as set forth in Article III of the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

- (a) Number. The number of directors shall be Five (5) or such other number as may be increased pursuant to the Article IV of the By-laws of the Corporation.
- (b) Election. Directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the members, which shall be held at the time and place duly designated by the Board of Directors.
- (c) Initial Board of Directors. The following persons are elected by the members of the said Corporation to serve it as directors until the first annual meeting of the Corporation:

ARTICLE VII. CAPITAL STOCK

The Corporation is not organized for profit. It shall have no capital stock and shall not be authorized to issue capital stock. All the matters relating to its members shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII. EARNINGS OF CORPORATION

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall be inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(C)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation, contribution to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code).

ARTICLE IX. DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME

The Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provision of any subsequent federal tax laws.

ARTICLE X. DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

ARTICLE XI. INCORPORATORS

ARTICLE XII. PROHIBITED ACTS

- (a) The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.

- (b) The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- (c) The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.
- (d) The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws.




