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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NORTH AMERICAN REGISTRY OF THE IRISH HORSE, INCORPORATED

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The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby make and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article 1 NAME

The name of the Corporation is North American Registry of the Irish Horse, Incorporated.

Article 2 INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal office of the Corporation is 4300 S.W. Boat Ramp Avenue, Palm City, Florida 34990.

Article 3
PURPOSE



The Corporation is organized, and shall be operated exclusively, to exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations, for any of the purposes set forth herein; to maintain a registry for Irish Horses in North America that meet the standards and registration requirements for registration with the Irish Horse Board in Ireland; to educate the public about Irish Horses; to promote the Irish Draught Horse, Irish Sport Horse, and Irish Hunter; and to do such other things as are incidental to the purposes of the Corporation or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish them.

The Corporation is a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida. The Corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit. No part of the income or assets of the

Corporation is distributed to or for the benefit of its Members, Trustees or Officers, except to the extent permissible under law. The Corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purpose.

Article 4 ELECTION OF TRUSTEES

The method of election of the Board of Trustees of the Corporation shall be as stated in the Bylaws.

Article 5 INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial Registered Office of the Corporation is 870 S.W. Martin Downs Boulevard, Palm City, Florida, and the name of its initial Registered Agent at that address is E. Barbara Baris.

Article 8 MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have Voting Members who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the Voting Members and shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote. The manner of termination of membership in the Corporation, and the rights, upon termination of membership, of the corporation, the terminated members, and the remaining members may be set forth in the Bylaws. The Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation or any amendment to them, and all rights and privileges conferred upon the Members, Trustees and Officers are subject to this reservation. The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Florida as amended from time to time, unless more specific provisions for amendments are adopted by the Corporation pursuant to law.

Article 12 INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify each Officer and Trustee, including former Officers and Trustees, to the full extent permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

Article 13 COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

In accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, the date when corporate existence shall commence is the date of subscription and acknowledgment of these Articles of Incorporation.
