ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

GREYHOUND COMMERCE PARK PROPERTY OWNER ASSOCIATION, INC.

a Florida nonprofit corporation

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 17.1006, Florida Satutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

Article IV: Term.

The entire paragraph is deleted in its entirety and in its place is inserted the following.

Article IV: <u>Term</u>: The term of the Association shall be perpetual. In the event of dissolution, any portions of the Properties consisting of the storm water management system shall be conveyed to a corporation not for profit which will accept responsibility; or, in the event an appropriate agency or government elects to accept the system, the storm water management system may be conveyed to either of those entities.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was: February 16, 2000.

THIRD: There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendment. The

amendment was adopted by the board of directors.
