

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

## ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

**Harmeyer, Inc.**

## ARTICLE II PRICIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

**1366 NW 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue Lauderhill, FL 33313**

## ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

Operation of Half-way houses for persons suffering from Alcoholism, AIDS and related diseases; conduct associated operations and training programs; accept contributions of securities and property; buy, sell, lease and mortgage real property, and buy, sell and borrow securities and personalty. Provide Housing for Low to moderate Income Owner Occupants. . Do all things necessary in order to further the basic operations.

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income Tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

## ARTICLE IV Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future Federal Tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.

## ARTICLE V MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS
