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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OLD APOSTOLIC CHURCH OF THE AMERICAS,

I, the undersigned, in order to form a corporation not for profit the purposes hereinafter stated, do hereby certify, as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be and is hereby declared to be OLD APOSTOLIC CHURCH OF THE AMERICAS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The street address of the initial principal office and the mailing address of the non-profit corporation is 736 Mill Stream, Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida 32082.

ARTICLE III

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized is for any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit and not specifically prohibited to corporations under other laws of this State which shall include, without limitation, charitable, benevolent, eleemosynary, educational, religious, social and fraternal.

In furtherance, and not in limitation of the general powers conferred by the Laws of the State of Florida and the objects and purposes herein set forth, it is expressly provided that this corporation shall also have the following powers, to-wit:

- (1) Have succession by its corporate name for the period set forth in its articles of incorporation.
 - (2) Sue and be sued and appear and defend in all actions

and proceedings in its corporate name to the same extent as a natural person.

- (3) Adopt, use, and alter a common corporate seal.

 However, such seal must always contain the words "corporation not for profit."
- (4) Elect or appoint such officers and agents as its affairs shall require and allow them reasonable compensation.
- (5) Adopt, change, amend, and repeal bylaws, not inconsistent with law or its articles of incorporation, for the administration of the affairs of the corporation and the exercise of its corporate powers.
- (6) Increase, by a vote of its members cast as the bylaws may direct, the number of its directors so that the number shall not be less than three but may be any number in excess thereof.
- (7) Make contracts and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage and pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, or income.
- (8) Conduct its affairs, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this act in any state, territory, district, or possession of the United States or any foreign country.
- (9) Purchase, take, receive, lease, take by gift, devise, or bequest, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use or otherwise deal in and with real or personal property, or any interest therein, whereever situated.

- (10) Acquire, enjoy, utilize, and dispose of patents, copyrights, and trademarks and any licenses and other rights or interests thereunder or therein.
- (11) Sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, lease, exchange, transfer, or otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- (12) Purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares and other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, whether for profit or not for profit, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States, or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district, municipality, or of any instrumentality thereof.
- (13) Lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds loaned or invested except as prohibited by Sec. 617.0833.
- (14) Make donations for the public welfare or for religious, charitable, scientific, educational, or other similar purposes.
- (15) Have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.
- (16) Merge with other corporations, both for profit and not for profit, domestic and foreign, if the surviving corporation is a corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE IV

The directors of the corporation not for profit, which shall not be less than three, shall be elected as provided by that method for the election of directors as stated in the not for profit corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

The street address of the not for profit corporation's initial registered office is 736 Mill Stream, Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida 32082, and the name of its initial registered agent is Pieter Mocke, whose address is 736 Mill Stream, Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida 32082.

ARTICLE VI
