ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FLA. S.O.S. INSTITUTE, INC.

The undersigned hereby subscribe to these Articles of Incorporation to form a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

I.

The name of the corporation shall be FLA. S.O.S. INSTITUTE, INC. Its principal office and its mailing address shall be 228 20th Avenue, N.E., St. Petersburg, Florida 33704.

II.

This corporation is organized for the purpose of assisting in the protection of the environment, especially that of promotion and assistance in the preservation and restoration of the sea and shoreline, of working for the accomplishment of that purpose, and of other purposes which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

III.

The method of election of directors of this corporation shall be as set out in the bylaws.

IV.

The date of commencement of corporate existence shall be January 1, 2000. The term for which the corporation is to exist shall be perpetual. In the event of dissolution of the corporation, no part of the corporation's earnings or assets shall inure to the benefit of any of its members; the residual assets of the corporation shall be distributed to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the federal, state, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
