Plan of Distribution of Assets

Pursuant to Section 617.1406, Florida Statutes, the Board of Directors of Citizen Review Panels for Hillsborough Children, Inc. (the "Corporation"), a not-for-profit Florida corporation hereby adopts the following plan for the distribution of assets:

- 1. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation were paid and discharged before the distribution of any Corporation assets;
- 2. All assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, are to be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements;
- 3. All assets received and held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, eleemosynary, benevolent, educational, or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of dissolution, are to be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic or foreign corporations, trusts, societies, or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the Corporation; and
- 4. All other assets, if any, are to be distributed in accordance with the Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws to the extent that the Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws determine the distributive rights of members, or any class or classes of members, or provide for distribution to others.
