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Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article One: The name of the corporation shall be:

Marriage and Family Enrichment Center, Inc.

Article Two: The name and address of the registered agent of the corporation, and who is also the person authorized to receive or sign legal papers on behalf of the corporation, is James Goosby 17100 SW 93 Ave Miami, Fl 33157

Article Three: The purpose(s) for which the corporation is being formed is Educational, Charitable, Literary and Scientific as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and distributions of assets to qualified 501\(\mathbb{Q}(3)\) upon dissolution of Marriage and family Enrichment Center, and/or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code."

Our purpose shall be to assist families to become economic self-sufficient by providing counseling in home ownership, and financial management. We will provide home ownership training; and follow-up counseling to ensure the long-range enhancement of low to moderate-income families. Our purpose is to actively seek out, advise, provide information, counseling, and acquisition assistance for first time home buyers; and to further assist them in developing strategies for long term family profitability.

Article six: The period of existence of the corporation -- shall be perpetual.

Article seven: Membership shall include those families who have received homes through our program. They have membership obligations, rights and privileges. These membership obligations, rights and privileges will be will be stated in the bylaws of the corporation. Membership shall be given without regard to Race, Religion, Gender, or National origin.

Article Eight: The Corporation's assets are dedicated to tax-exempt purposes. The corporation shall limit it's corporate purposes to allowable 501(c)(3) purposes, and will not authorize or engage in any substantial proportion in political activities that do not further our stated tax-exempt purposes. Furthermore, our educational purposes compasses a broad spectrum, including instruction home ownership training, and related training for both self-development and for the community's benefit. This educational training shall take the form of classroom and/or video instruction.

Our charitable purposes is defined as "providing homeownership education courses, first-time purchase assistance and financial management, services to low and medium income families"; and we consider assisting low-moderate income families training in home ownership and purchase support as being beneficial to the public interest. The class individuals we will benefit are those in the low-moderate income level. Our literary purposes -is defined as publishing and distribution of literary material concerning homeownership and financial management training that would be in the interest of low and medium income families.

Article Nine: The Directors of the corporation shall serve voluntary and without compensation, except allowance shall be made for expenses. Allowable expenses shall be determined by a qualified CPA using the current tax code of the Internal Revenue Service as the reference, as regard non-profit corporations.

Article Ten: Membership in the corporation shall entitle each member to all the privileges of the corporation or association, but shall not entitle a member to any pecuniary or financial profit of any form or kind, and in the event the member shall resign, be suspended or expelled or membership terminated in accordance with any of the Bylaws or the rules of the corporation, membership in the corporation shall give the holder thereof no right or privilege or interest in the property of the said corporation.

Upon dissolution of this corporation, all of its assets remaining after payment of its debts and all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed in the manner proved by a resolution of the majority of the membership as provided by law to one or more charitable organizations or institutions formed for purposed similar to those of this corporation, provided that such organization or institution shall be qualified for exemption under §. 501 (c) (6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and further

provided that none of the assets shall be distributed in such dissolution to any member, officer, director or trustee of this corporation.
