#### ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NAPLES CHAMBER PAC, INC. (a Corporation Not For Profit)

Naples, Chamber PAC, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby certifies as follows:
