AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION,

FOR

OO SEP 28 M 10 13 LESS COUNTY COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS, FLORIDA, INC.

At a duly constituted meeting of the Corporation Board of Directors held 25 September 2000, at the offices of the incorporated the following language amending the Corporation's Articles of Incorporation were adopted and the incorporator instructed to file such amendment with the Secretary of State for the purpose of amending the articles to comply with the Internal Revenue Services' 501(c)(3) Organizational Test.

ARTICLE VII: CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES AND ASSETS DEDICATED THERETO

- 1. Said Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
- 2. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall insure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes.
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
- 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a Corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).
- 5. Upon dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) or shall be distributed to the Federal, State or Local Government for a public purpose.

There being no members of the Corporation, this Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was unanimously adopted by a properly convened meeting the Corporation's Board of Directors dated 25 September 2000.
