CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE KOURTNEY NICOLE SCHMIDT FOUNDATION, INC. (a Domestic Nonprofit Corporation)

SECRETARY DE FLORIDA

To: The Secretary of State State of Florida

THE UNDERSIGNED, of the age of eighteen years or over, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act, hereby executes the following Certificate of Incorporation:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is The Kourtney Nicole Schmidt Foundation,

- 2. The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or any corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Such charitable, educational and scientific purposes shall include, but are not limited to, providing specialty playground equipment for handicapped children to be placed in public facilities.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the preceding paragraph. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at a time and in a manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation will not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation will not make any investments in a manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

- 3. The Corporation is to have no members.
- 4. The method of electing Directors shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of the Corporation.
- 5. To the fullest extent from time to time permitted by law, a director or officer of the Corporation shall not be personally liable to the Corporation for damages for breach of any duty owed to the Corporation, except that this provision shall not relieve a director or officer from liability for any breach of duty based upon an act or omission (i) in breach of such person's duty of loyalty to the Corporation; (ii) not in good faith or involving a knowing violation of law; or (iii) resulting in receipt by such person of an improper personal benefit. If the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act hereafter is amended to authorize the further elimination or limitation of liability of directors or officers, then the liability of such director or officer of the Corporation, in

addition to the limitation on personal liability provided herein, shall be limited to the fullest extent permitted by such amendment. Any repeal or modification of this section of the Certificate of Incorporation shall be prospective only, and shall not adversely affect any limitation on the personal liability of a director or officer of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.
