Purpose of Form-

A person who is required to file an information return with the IRS must get your correct taxpayer identification number (TIM) to report, for example, income paid to you, real estate transactions, mortgage interest you paid, acquisition or abandonment of secured property, cancellation of debt, or contributions you made to an IRA.
