ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
CONTINENTAL GULF INTERNATIONAL ADVISORS, INC.

I, the undersigned, do hereby organize myself for the purpose of becoming a corporation for profit under Florida law.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is: CONTINENTAL GULF INTERNATIONAL ADVISORS, INC..

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

This corporation may provide consultation, management, and assistance in all types of political campaigns and elections, including but not necessarily limited to, candidate advice; assistance with political advertising; public relations activities; individual and issue oriented campaign assistance to candidates; political instruction and workshop training sessions for candidates; political fund raising; and political financial management.

The corporation may also engage in historical research in connection with the development, creation, and/or publication of historical books, articles, and other miscellaneous written works.

The corporation may conduct other functions and enterprises related to any of the foregoing activities that are not prohibited by law.

ARTICLE IV

The aggregate number of shares which this corporation is authorized to issue is One Hundred Thousand (100,000), all of which shall be common shares with a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE V

Each shareholder of any class of stock of this corporation has full preemptive rights to purchase any unissued shares of the corporation at the price at which such shares are offered to others. Each shareholder of any class of stock of this corporation is also entitled to full preemptive rights to purchase any shares held or owned by other shareholders of this corporation. Each shareholder of any class of stock of this corporation shall also be entitled to full preemptive rights to purchase any corporate securities carrying rights of subscription to, and/or acquisition of, any unissued or treasury stock.

However, under no circumstances, shall this corporation issue a number of shares to any shareholder which gives that shareholder a number of shares that exceeds the number owned by PETER G. BAKOS. The existing shareholders shall determine, by a majority vote, the consideration to be received by the corporation for the shares, if any, issued after the initial stock issuance.

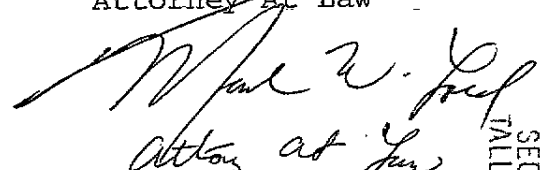
