



Enclosed with this letter to you please find completed and signed Corporation Reinstatement form which I ask be accepted and filed on behalf of the above referenced corporation. Also included with this form and letter is a check from Mr. Hogan, co-owner of the corporation in the amount of \$458.75, representing the fees for the Uniform Business Report filings for years 2003, 2004, and 2005, and also the fee for the certified copy with regard to the 2005 filing.

Mr. and Mrs. Hogan have owned and operated the concern owned by the corporation continuously from 2000 up through and included 2005; for some reason they never received the Uniform Business Report for 2003 which they would have filed promptly, as in prior years. It should also be noted that Mr. and Mrs. Hogan never received the notice of dissolution, either. During March, 2003, the corporation was in the process of selling off its assets and directly related business activity (although other activity of the corporation has been ongoing and active since the actual sale); also Mr. and Mrs. Hogan were undergoing considerable turmoil in their personal lives to include repercussions from Mr. Hogan's divorce, his dependent kids, and also the fact that Ms. Hogan had been called out of state repeatedly to care for her elderly parents, and also other relatives. Furthermore, Mr. and Mrs. Hogan were in the process of relocating to another address (locally), and we all know the stress that even a local move can impose, and more especially when coupled with other extenuating factors. Mr. and Mrs. Hogan are now situated in their permanent residence and with the sale of the business assets, and family members somewhat back to normal, are finally

piecing their lives back together.

In lieu of the above, it is asked that the \$600.00 Reinstatement Fee be abated as it was clearly not the intent of Mr. and Mrs. Hogan to not file the Uniform Business Report on behalf of their corporation.
