**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

- FIRST** The name of this corporation shall be: PATRICK'S PAPERHANGING CO., INC.
- SECOND** The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:
6358 Robinson Street, Jupiter, Florida 33458
- THIRD** The number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding
at any one time is: One Hundred (100) shares of no Par Value
- FOURTH** The name and Florida street address of the initial registered agent is:
Patrick A. Osetek, 6358 Robinson Street, Jupiter, Florida 33458
- FIFTH** The name and street address of the incorporator of these Articles of Incorporation is:
Patrick A. Osetek, 6358 Robinson Street, Jupiter, Florida 33458
- SIXTH:** The nature of the business and, the objects and purposes to be transacted, promoted
and carried on, are to do any or all the things herein mentioned, as fully and to the
same extent as natural persons might or could do, and in any part of the world, viz:
"The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which
corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act."
- SEVENTH:** The powers of the incorporator are to terminate upon filing of the certificate of
incorporation, and the name(s) and mailing address(es) of persons who are to serve as
director(s) until the first annual meeting of stockholders or until their successors are
elected and qualify are as follow:

- EIGHTH:** The Directors shall have power to make and to alter or amend the By-Laws; to fix the
amount to be reserved as working capital, and to authorize and cause to be executed,

capital stock issued and outstanding, the Directors shall have the authority to dispose
in any manner, of the whole property of this corporation.

and no stockholder shall have any right of inspecting any account, or book or

The stockholders and directors shall have power to hold their meetings and keep the books, documents and papers of the Corporation outside of the State of Florida, at such places as may be from time to time designated by the By-Laws or by resolution of the stockholders or directors, except as *otherwise* required by the laws of Florida.

It is the intention that the objects, purposes and powers specified in the Third paragraph hereof shall, except where *otherwise* specified in said paragraph, be nowise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph in this certificate of incorporation, but that the objects, purposes and powers specified in the Third paragraph and in each of the clauses or paragraphs of this charter shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.


NINTH: Directors of the corporation shall not be liable to either the corporation or its stockholders for monetary damages for a breach of fiduciary duties unless the breach involves: (1) a director's duty of loyalty to the corporation or its stockholders; (2) acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; (3) liability for unlawful payments of dividends or unlawful stock purchases or redemption by the corporation; or (4) a transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit.
