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#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

#### ARLENE S. LEFCOURT, P.A.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Professional Services Corporation Act of the State of Florida the undersigned Arlene S. Lefcourt, being a duly licensed real estate agent does hereby make, organize and form a professional service corporation under the following Articles of Incorporation to wit:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name and address of the corporation is:
