ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

COIMBRA CONSULTANTS COMPANY



The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby associate themselves to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is COIMBRA CONSULTANTS COMPANY

ARTICLE II. NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of and invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property, and services, of every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, surety, express, railroad, canal, telegraph, telephone or cemetery company, a building and loan association, mutual fire insurance association, cooperative association, fraternal benefits society, state fair or exposition.

To conduct business in, have one or more offices in, and buy, hold, mortgage, sell, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of real and personal property, including franchises, patents, copyrights, trademarks and licenses, in the State of Florida and in all other states and countries.

To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers or corporate property or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the
capital stock of, or any bond, securities, or other evidences of
indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of
Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such
stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

In general, to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the General Corporation Law of Florida, and to possess and exercise all the powers and privileges granted by the General Corporation Law of Florida or by any other law of Florida or by these Articles of Incorporation

together with any powers incidental thereto, so far as such powers and privileges are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business or purpose of the corporation.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 7,500 shares of common stock having a nominal or par value of \$1.00 per share.

This corporation shall begin as soon as possible and is to exist perpetually.
