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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF RICLAC, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of RICLAC, INC. under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is:

ARTICLE III - COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation will commence on the date of filing these articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

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ARTICLE V - AUTHORIZED SHARES
