ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BUSHCO, INC. (JACKSONVILLE)



The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article I

Name and Principal Office

Section 1.1. Name. The name of the corporation is BUSHCO, INC. (JACKSONVILLE).

Section 1.2. Principal Office. The street address and mailing address of the principal office of the corporation is 9850 Atlantic Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32225.

Article II

Duration

Section 2.1. Duration. This corporation shall exist perpetually.
