ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LAWLOR REALTY COMPANY (A Florida Corporation For Profit)

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be LAWLOR REALTY COMPANY (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II. DEFINITIONS

- A. The principal place of business is 4400 North Federal Highway, Suite 52, Boca Raton, Florida 33431.
- B. "<u>Corporation</u>" as used herein shall mean the corporation for profit, the corporation formed by these Articles, its successors or assigns.

ARTICLE III. CAPITALIZATION
