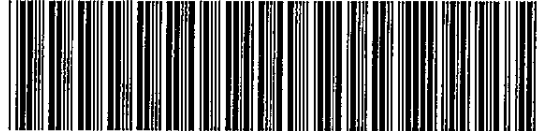

STATE OF KANSAS  
LEGAL ASSUMPTION OF NAME  
CONFORMING TO THE COMMON LAW RULES

IN RECOGNITION of the well-established principle of statutory construction that the common law is still in effect unless a statute clearly and explicitly excludes an action (N.R.&H.A. v. C.&P.T.C., 104 S.Ct. 304, 1983; see K.S.A. 77-109), and that "in the absence of statutory prohibition, a person, without abandoning his real name, may adopt or assume a name, and he may use such assumed name to identify himself in the transaction of his business, the execution of contracts, and the carrying on of his affairs" so long as such assumption is not entered into for the purpose of defrauding others (Kreuter v. U.S., 201 F2d 33, 10th Cir., 1952), and that no such prohibition currently exists in the Kansas Statutes (see K.S.A. 60-1402), and that "...so long as no fraud [is] intended, any person...[has] the right to change his name without legal formality by simply using the new name" (re Application to Change Name, 10 Kan App 2d 625, 706 P.2d 480) because "it is the identity of the individual that is regarded and not the name which he or she may bear or assume" (Sanders v. Sitton, 179 Kan. 118, 292 P.2d 1099), and that an individual is "legally entitled to use that name as his own" (U.S. v. Cox, 593 F2d 46, 6th Cir., 1979), and that such assumption without court action is widely employed, accepted, and recognized by society at large (e.g. in the establishment of a marriage),

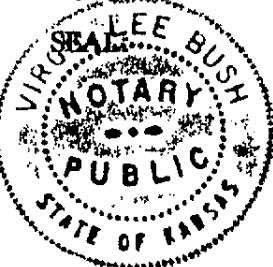
