I am the president of a small woman-owned business (S-Corporation) that just incorporated last year. At this time, the corporation employs only myself as a part-time employee so the company cannot afford to hire an accountant or bookkeeper even as a part time employee. All of our accounting, taxes, etc. must, therefore, be done by myself or my husband in our spare time. Given the limited amount of time that we can devote to accounting, our limited backgrounds with accounting, and the fact that this is our first year in business, we neglected to realize until this week that we needed to submit the 2001 Uniform Business Report.
