ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PATRICIA A. CLARK, Psy. D., P.A.

The undersigned natural person, competent and licensed to practice psychology in the State of Florida, acting hereby as Incorporator for the purpose of forming a Professional Service Corporation for profit under the provisions of Section 607, Florida General Corporation Act, and Section 621, Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, of the Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

I.

Name of Corporation The name of this corporation shall be PATRICIA A. CLARK, Psy. D., P.A. II. Purposes The general nature and purposes of business to be transacted, promoted and care of the corporation are as follows:

- a. To engage in every aspect in the practice of psychology, and all its fields of specializations, as are engaged by psychologists.
- b. To engage and render the professional services involved only through its officers, agents and employees who shall be in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional service as this corporation.
- c. To invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds and any other type of investments permitted by law.
- d. To engage in no other business other than the rendition of the professional services specified herein.
- e. To do everything necessary and proper in accomplishing the purposes herein set forth and to do anything incidental thereto which is not forbidden under the laws of the State of Florida.

III.

Capital Stock

- a. The maximum number of shares of stock that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 1000 shares of common stock at \$1.00 per share par value.
- b. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be payable in lawful money or property, labor or services.
- c. Shares of the corporation's stock and certificates shall be issued only to psychologists in good standing and duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized within the State of Florida to render the same professional services as this corporation.

IV.

Duration

The corporation's existence shall commence upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State of the State of Florida, and this corporation is to exist perpetually.

V.

Registered Agent

The street address of the initial principal office and registered office of this corporation is 255 North Lakemont Avenue, Suite 211, Winter Park, Florida 32792, and the name of its initial registered agent at said address is PATRICIA A. CLARK, Psy. D.

VI.

Incorporator

Board of Directors

The corporation shall have a board of Directors consisting of one (1) person. The number of Directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by a resolution of the majority of the Stockholders but shall never be less than one. VIII.

Informal Shareholder Action

Any action of the Shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the action so taken shall be signed by all the Shareholders entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting and filed with the Secretary of the corporation as part of the corporate records.

IX.

Severance and Termination of Employment

If any officer, director, stockholder, agent or employee of this corporation becomes legally disqualified to render the professional services for which the corporation is organized, or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations on his or her continued rendering of such professional services, he or she shall forthwith sever all employment with the corporation, and shall not thereafter participate or share, directly or indirectly, in any earnings or profits realized by the corporation on account of professional services. The corporation shall forthwith, upon such disqualification of any shareholder, purchase such shareholder's share and pay him or her all amounts owing and lawfully due to him or her by the corporation, except that such shares shall not be entitled to dividends.

X.

Informal Director Action

If all of the Directors severally or collectively consent in writing to any action taken or to be taken by the corporation, and the writings evidencing their consent are filed with the Secretary of the corporation, the action shall be as valid as though it had been authorized at a meeting of the Board of Directors.

XI.

Indemnification

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

XII.

Bylaw Amendment

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal the bylaws of this corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors and Stockholders provided that such amendment be in compliance with the laws of Florida governing a Professional Service Corporation.
