AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of section 607 1006, Florida Statutes, this corporation hereby adopts the following amendment to is Articles of Incorporation:

The shall be amended to read;

FIRST:

Auburndale, Florida 33823.

SECOND:

Article 5 - Officers shall be amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

Such officers shall serve until their successors are elected or appointed.

THIRD:

Articles 6 - Directors shall be amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:
