ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF Gallery Depot, Inc.

The undersigned hereby adopts the following articles SEE, FLORIDA incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of this corporation is Gallery Depot, Inc.

ARTICLE II - Duration

This corporation is to commence its corporate existence on the date of filing and shall exist perpetually thereafter until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III - Purpose

The corporation is organized for the purpose of web based business such as virtual malls.

ARTICLE IV - Stated Capital
