The undersigned incorporator to these Articles of Incorporation, all of whom are duly licensed and competent to contract for development of yearly calendars, and any and all other related activities, hereby forms a corporation for profit pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act and other laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation is: CAMPUS CALENDARS, CORP.

ARTICLE II

Existence

The corporation's existence shall commence on April 1, 2000.

ARTICLE III

Nature of Corporate Business and Powers

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation shall be:

- A. To engage in every aspect and phase of the yearly calendar business and all related services authorized to render.
- B. To invest and reinvest the funds of this corporation in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds of any other type of investments within the meaning of Chapter 621.08, Florida Statutes, and to acquire and own real and personal property necessary for the rendering of professional services.

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C.
