ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JAMES L. FARNSWORTH, PA, CPA

TASECRETE PH 3:53

The undersigned incorporator is a licensed accountant in the State of Florida and is forming a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the corporation.

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is James L. Farnsworth, PA, CPA.

ARTICLE II - Principal Office and Initial Registered Agent

The address of the corporation's principal office is 121 Shadow Lane, Lakeland, Polk County, Florida 33813. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation located at that office is James L. Farnsworth.

ARTICLE III - Duration

The corporation shall exist perpetually until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IV - Purpose

The sole purpose of the corporation is to practice accounting.

ARTICLE V - Capital Stock

The total number of shares of stock which the corporation shall be authorized to issue or have outstanding at any one time is one thousand (1,000) shares. These shares shall be of a single class of common stock, and shall have a value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE VI - Capitalization

The amount of capital with which the corporation will begin is One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

ARTICLE VII - Corporate Powers

The corporation shall have all the rights and powers now or subsequently conferred on professional corporations by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IX - Directors

The corporation is to be managed by a board of directors. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors is one, and the name and address of the initial director are:

The initial director shall hold office until his successor is elected and qualified as provided in the bylaws. Then the term of office of each director shall be one (1) year and until the election and qualification of a successor. ARTICLE X - Bylaws

of Incorporation. Following the adoption of bylaws by the affirmative vote of a majority of the shareholders, the affairs of the corporation are to be regulated and managed in accordance with the bylaws.

ARTICLE XI - Dissolution

The corporation may be dissolved at any time (i) by unanimous written consent of the shareholders; or (ii) on the affirmative vote of the holders of at least a majority of the outstanding shares of the corporation entitled to vote. On dissolution, the corporate property and assets shall, after payment of all debts of the corporation, be distributed to the shareholders pro rata, each shareholder to participate in the distribution in direct proportion to the number of shares held by the shareholder.


