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CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

BLACK GOLD INVESTMENT & DEVELOPMENT CORP.

We, the undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Florida approved June 1, 1925, and the acts amendatory thereto, do hereby subscribe to this Certificate of Incorporation.

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is:

BLACK GOLD INVESTMENT & DEVELOPMENT CORP.

SECOND: The general nature of business to be transacted by the Corporation is as follows: To purchase, sell, lease, and develop Real Estate. To lend money. To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own and mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invent, trade, deal in and with goods, wares, merchandise and other personal and real property of every class and description whatsoever.
