Please find enclosed my Annual Report/Uniform Business Report. This was returned to me with an explanation of why it had not been filed. After speaking with your office, it was suggested that I write to you again with further clarification of why the report was initially filed late, so that my request for a waiver of the late fee can be taken into consideration.

Much of my work requires that I travel outside the United States. I spent most of the past winter in Europe. In my absence, I had forwarded all my mail to my accountant.
