To Whom It May Concern:

I am aware that there is no provision in statute to waive fees if your uniform business report is late. But I am asking for an exception because of my particular circumstances.

My S-corporation was incorporated on April 19, 2000. This is my first time as a business owner and I was unaware that I had to file an annual report. The lawyer who helped me file my papers did not advise me of this either. Then to make matters worse, I moved in March of 2001 and even though I changed my address with the post office, there was a mix-up and I did not get all my mail on a timely basis. This month, the post office sent me a package of mail that was not delivered to my new address and in the package I found the "Notice of administrative dissolution or revocation" from the state of Florida. I panicked because I cannot pay the appropriate fees of \$750.00 to reinstate my corporation. My business is struggling financially, and I had a loss in 2000 and will also have a loss in 2001. I have attached a copy of my federal income tax return for your review, which shows that I had a \$10,748.00 loss. Paying the \$750.00 instead of the normal fee of \$150.00 would add an additional burden to my already struggling business. Can you please be so kind as to waive the reinstatement fees this one time? I promise that this will not happen again, it was due to a combination of inexperience and a post office mix-up.
