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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

RESOURCE TECHNOLOGIES CORPORATION

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<u>ARTICLE I</u> Name and Dura<u>tion</u>

The name of the Corporation is Resource Technologies Corporation The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. The effective date upon which this Corporation shall come into existence shall be the date these Articles are filed by the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE II Principal Office

The address of the principal office of the Corporation is 250 North Orange Avenue, Suite 900, Orlando, Florida 32801.

ARTICLE III Registered Office and Agent

The address of the registered office in the State of Florida is 250 North Orange Avenue, Penthouse Suite, Orlando, Florida 32801. The name of the registered agent at such address is John L. Brewerton, III, P.A.

ARTICLE IV Corporate Purposes, Powers and Rights

- 1. The nature of the business to be conducted or promoted and the purposes of the Corporation are to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Business Corporation Act.
- 2. In furtherance of its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all of the general and specific powers and rights granted to and conferred on a corporation by the Florida Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE V Capital Stock

The total number of shares of capital stock which the Corporation has the authority to issue is 750,000 shares of Common Stock ("Common Stock"), par value \$0.01 per share.

ARTICLE VII

Board of Directors

- 1. The number of members of the Board of Directors shall initially be one (1), which number thereafter may be increased or diminished from time to time as provided by the Bylaws; *provided, however*, that there shall never be less than one. Each director shall serve until the next annual meeting of shareholders.
- 2. If any vacancy occurs in the Board of Directors during a term, the remaining directors, by affirmative vote of a majority thereof, may elect a director to fill the vacancy until the next annual meeting of shareholders.
- 3. The name of the person who shall serve as initial director of the Corporation until the first meeting of the shareholders is John Lee Brewerton, III. The street address of such person is 250 North Orange Avenue, Penthouse Suite, Orlando, Florida 32801.

ARTICLE VIII

<u>Amendment</u>

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon shareholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE IX

Preemptive Rights

Every shareholder, upon the sale of any additional stock of this Corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he or she already holds or of any bonds, debentures, or other securities convertible into stock of the same kind, class or series as that which he or she already holds, shall have the right to purchase his or her pro rata share thereof (as early as may be done without the issuance of fractional shares) subject to the same terms and at the same price at which such stock is offered to others.

ARTICLE X Cumulative Voting

At all elections of directors, each holder of Common Stock is entitled to as many votes as equals the number of his shares of Common Stock multiplied by the number of directors to be elected, and he or she may cast all of such votes for a single director or may distribute them among the number to be voted for, or any two or more of them, as he or she may see fit.

ARTICLE XI

Bylaws

The power to adopt, amend or repeal bylaws for the management of this Corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors or the shareholders, but the Board of Directors may not amend or repeal any bylaw adopted by the shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide that such bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XII

Indemnification

The Corporation shall indemnify any incorporator, officer or director, or any former incorporator, officer or director, to the full extent permitted by applicable law.

ARTICLE XIII

Transfer of Shares

If, from time to time, a shareholders' Subchapter S election (of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States) or any other agreement among all of the shareholders of the Corporation is in effect, then transfers of the Corporation's Common Stock not made in accordance with such agreement, whether by operation of law or otherwise, shall be null and void, *ab initio*.
