

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

JALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned natural person competent to contract, hereby makes, subscribes and acknowledges these Articles of Incorporation in order to organize and incorporate a business for profit, with the corporate name as stated in Article I.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is VINCE E. TURNER, P.A.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the purpose of providing legal services and for the purpose of transacting any or all lawful business under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of One Dollar and no/100 (\$1.00) par value common stock.

ARTICLE IV - TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these Articles.

ARTICLE V - ADDRESS

The principal place of business of this Corporation is to be 190 Avenue A, N.W., Winter Haven, FL 33881. The mailing address of this Corporation is P.O. Drawer 230, Winter Haven, FL 33882-0230. The registered officer at that address is Vince E. Turner.

ARTICLE VI - DIRECTORS

There shall be a Board of Directors for this corporation which shall consist of not less than one (1), nor more that twenty (20), the number of the same to be fixed by the Board of Directors or by the corporate By-Laws. Each of said Directors shall be of full age and at least one of them shall be a citizen of the United

States, as provided by the corporate laws of the State of Florida. A quorum for the transaction of business shall be a majority of the Directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Directors. Subject to the By-Laws, if any, adopted by the Stockholders, the Directors may make the By-Laws, if any, adopted by the Stockholders, the Directors may make the By-Laws, and meetings of the Directors may be held within or without the State of Florida. Directors need not be Stockholders.

ARTICLE VII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ARTICLE X - SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The following special provisions, power privileges, and limitations shall be applicable to and govern this corporation:

The Board of Directors shall be elected annually by the stockholders at their Annual Meeting, or at a special meeting held for that purpose. All vacancies in the Board shall be filled by the Stockholders.

The Stockholders shall have power by resolution to appoint an Executive Committee of not less than two (2) of their number, or any officer or agent, with the power to sub-delegate, who, to the extent provided for in the Resolution, or in the By-Laws of this corporation, shall have and may exercise the powers of the Board of Directors in the management of the affairs and property of this corporation, and the exercise of the corporation powers.

This corporation is authorized to have a President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary and such other Officers as the Board my provide. Only the President need be a Director. Any person may hold two or more offices. Officers need not be stockholders. Officers, other than Directors, shall be elected by the Directors at the first meeting next after the Annual Meeting of Stockholders, or as soon thereafter as may be practicable. Each Officer and each Director shall hold office until his successor shall be elected and qualified. The duties, powers, and functions of the Officers and Board of Directors shall be such as usually devolve upon such Officers, unless otherwise prescribed by the By-Laws.

Members of the Board of Directors or Stockholders may participate in a meeting of such Board or of Stockholders by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting.

The original subscribers of incorporation of this corporation may sell, exchange, assign or transfer all of the stock subscribed for them in these Articles of Incorporation, and deliver these Articles of Incorporation, together with the good will and corporate franchises of the corporation to the transferred or assignees; and in such event, all offices designated approved at the stockholders' meeting by a majority of fifty-one percent (51%) of the stock entitled to vote thereon, unless all the Directors and all of the

Stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of Incorporation be made.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENT


