The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is: **Thorell, Inc.**

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE


