ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this Corporation is ROBISON & GRAMLICH, P.A. The mailing address of the Corporation is 1201 Fifth Avenue, North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33705.

ARTICLE II. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing upon the filing of these Articles with the Florida Secretary of State.

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation is health care and to engage in every phase and aspect of the business of rendering the professional services to the public that a physician duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida, is authorized to render, but such professional services shall be rendered only through officers, employees and agents of this corporation who are duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida to perform said services.

ARTICLE IV: POWERS

The Corporation shall have the power:

SECTION 4.1 To sue and be sued, complain, and defend in its corporate name in all actions or proceedings.

SECTION 4.2 To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.

SECTION 4.3 To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.

SECTION 4.4 To lend money to and use its credit to assist its officers and employees to the full extent permitted by law.

SECTION 4.5 To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage,

lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.

SECTION 4.6 To make contracts and guaranties and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the Corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its assets.

SECTION 4.7 To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.

SECTION 4.8 To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by the laws of the State of Florida within or without the State of Florida.

SECTION 4.9 To elect or appoint officers and agents of the Corporation and define their duties and fix their compensation.

SECTION 4.10 To make and alter bylaws for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the Corporation.

SECTION 4.11 To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.

SECTION 4.12 To transact any lawful business which the Board of Directors shall find will be in the best interest of the Corporation.

SECTION 4.14 To provide insurance for its benefit on the life of any of its directors, officers, or employees, or on the life of any shareholder for the purpose of acquiring at his death shares of its stock owned by the shareholder or by the spouse or children of the shareholder.

SECTION 4.15 To be a promoter, incorporator, general partner, limited partner, member, associate, or manager of any corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise.

SECTION 4.16 To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purposes.

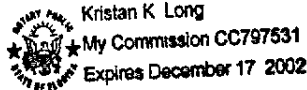
