ARTICLE XI AMENDMENTS

These Articles of Incorporation for ROORKEE SYSTEMS, INC., may be amended in the manner provided by Florida Law.

ARTICLE XII INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:
