ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SOUTHERN PROFESSIONAL WOOD CARE COMPANY

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is SOUTHERN PROFESSIONAL WOOD CARE COMPANY.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

ARTICLE VIII - BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal by-laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

ARTICLE IX - RESTRICTIONS ON TRANSFER OF STOCK

The corporation, and subject to the priority of the corporation, the remaining stockholders of the corporation, shall have a preference in the purchase of any shares of the capital stock of the corporation, and any attempted sale of such shares of stock in violation of this provision shall be null and void. In the event that the corporation is legally unable to purchase such stock or otherwise waives its privilege of purchasing, the Secretary of the corporation shall mail a written notice to all of the remaining stockholders, by certified mail, return receipt requested, advising them of the terms of such offer, and unless the terms of such offer are accepted by any or all of the other stockholders within ten days from the date of mailing such notice, they shall be deemed to have waived their privilege of purchasing, stockholders or the person in privity with him desiring to sell shall be at liberty to effect a sale upon the terms of such offer. stockholder who has given notice pursuant to this article, thereafter sell such stock for a price or upon terms different than the offer contained in such notice, without again complying with the notice requirements of this article. Neither the corporation, nor the remaining stockholders (collectively), may exercise their privilege of purchasing as to any shares of stock less than the total number of shares involved in such offer.

ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any
