

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
K&J CLAIMS SERVICES OF AMERICA, INC.**

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ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be K&J Claims Services of America, Inc.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida's General Corporation Act.


ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS


