We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida Article I

The name of the corporation shall be HyperPub Incorporated

Article II

Nature of Business

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is dynamic publishing and other activities or businesses permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.
