In January of 2002, I moved to a bridgeless barrier island in Charlotte County, FL. My small home-run business moved as well. I did not receive the form for the annual report. I just got back from an appointment with my new accountant and she asked me if I had paid the report for last year. I looked through my checkbook and realized the last one I paid was for the year 2001, check # 1018 paid on 1/31/01. My accountant from last year never mentioned it- although since he never returns a phone call, I couldn't expect him to ask me about an annual report. His gross negligence in accounting has resulted in my new accountant having to review 2 years of tax papers.
