ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

MAESTRO SOCCER ACADEMY, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following articles of incorporation, providing for the formation, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation for profit.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation (hereinafter called the Corporation) is Maestro Soccer Academy, Inc. The business address of the corporation is 9104 S.W. 180 Street, Miami, Florida 33157.

ARTICLE II

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the Corporation is initially organized, which shall continue to be the purposes of the Corporation until and if the same shall be amended pursuant to the provisions of the Florida General Corporation Act, and which shall include the authority of the Corporation to transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporation Act.

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to be issued is One Hundred (100). Such shares shall be of a single class (capital stock), shall be \$1.00 per share par value, and shall be known as Section 1244 Stock as such stock term is defined in the Internal Revenue Service.

Each share of the Corporation shall entitle the holder thereof to a preemptive right, for a period of thirty (30) days, to subscribe for, purchase or otherwise acquire any shares of the same class of the Corporation or any equity and/or voting shares of any class of the Corporation which the Corporation proposes to issue or any rights or options the Corporation purposes to grant for the purchase of shares of the same class of the Corporation or of equity and/or voting shares of any class of the Corporation or for the purpose of any shares, bonds, securities or obligations of the Corporation which are convertible into or exchangeable for, or which carry any rights, to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire shares of the same class of the Corporation or equity and/or voting shares of any class of the Corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized or created, whether having unissued or treasury status, and whether the proposed issue, reissue, transfer, or grant is for cash, property, or any other lawful consideration; and after the expiration of said thirty (30) days, any and all of such shares, rights, options, bonds, securities or obligations of the Corporation may be issued, reissued, transferred, or granted by the board of Directors, as the case may be, to such persons, firms, corporations, and associations and for such lawful consideration, and on such terms, as the Board of Directors in its discretion may determine. As

used herein, the terms "equity share" and "voting share" shall mean, respectively, shares which confer unlimited dividend rights and shares which confer unlimited voting rights in the election of one or more directors.

ARTICLE VI

The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation in the State of Florida is: 7103 S.W. 102 Avenue, Suite A, Miami, Florida 33173 in the County of Dade and the name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address is Deborah R. Waks, Esquire.

ARTICLE VII
