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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
IBEC OF FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, the natural person, competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation will be:

IBEC OF FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES/NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

A) Any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares that this corporation is to have outstanding at any one time is One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock, having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.
