
To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter in hopes that I may reinstate my corporation without paying the reinstatement penalty. I incorporated in the year 2000 from the advice of the people whom I purchased the business from. I didn't know however of the annual renewal fee until later. I am now having to pay a huge penalty regarding my taxes and he is no where to be found. He was an individual simply working out of his home and I only got all of my accounting/bookkeeping papers back from the landlord where he was living. He abandoned his apartment and most everything was left. Thank God, so was all my paperwork. Which brings us to now? I am trying to pick up the pieces and take care of everything I pre-paid him for. Lesson learned.

Please find it in your heart to reinstate my corporation with this my \$150.00 renewal payment. The landlord told me if you needed a letter, notarized or otherwise, to confirm what I have told you he would do so. I thank you for your time in reading my plea and will truly appreciate your understanding of this unfortunate and embarrassing matter.
