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CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

JAX PANORAMIC SERVICES, INC.

We, the undersigned, in order to form a Corporation for profit for the purpose hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Statutes, do hereby subscribe to this Certificate of Incorporation, and to adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be **JAX PANORAMIC SERVICES, INC.**

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on by this Corporation shall be:

- (a) This Corporation is organized with the purpose to engage in the painting business and all other lawful activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America.
- (b) To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, or corporation, town, city, county, state, territory or government.
- (c) To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain or otherwise dispose of and deal in lands and leaseholds, and any franchises, rights in real property, and personal or mixed property, and any rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed and to have any and all powers above set forth as fully as natural person, whether as principals, agents, trustees or otherwise.
- (d) To guarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation or corporations organized under the

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laws of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while the owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the rights to vote thereon.

ARTICLE XII


In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers conferred by Statutes, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized to:


