ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to Chapter 607, Florida Statutes, does hereby adopt the following Articles Of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is: REALSTATE, INC.

ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual, unless sooner voluntarily dissolved according to law, and the existence of the Corporation commences at the time of subscription and acknowledgment of these Articles Of Incorporation on July 25, 2000, provided that these Articles Of Incorporation are filed by the Department of State within five (5) days, exclusive of legal holidays, after such subscription and acknowledgment, and in the event these Articles Of Incorporation are not filed by the Department of State within such period, the corporate existence shall commence upon the filing of the Articles Of Incorporation by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE AND POWERS

The general purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(1) To buy, sell, exchange, lease, mortgage, or otherwise acquire or dispose of real or personal property and any interest or right therein, and to hold, own, operate, control, maintain,

manage, and develop such property and interest in any manner that may be necessary, useful, or advantageous for the purposes of the Corporation.
