
This letter is in response to your letter dated November 21, 2001, [copy enclosed] regarding the waiver of the \$400.00 late fee.

According to Mr. Phillip P. Ficarrota, the sole shareholder and president of Warrior Communications, Inc., the original uniform business report (UBR) was never received by him. Mr. Ficarrota's former accounting firm, Caprice, Nelson, Albano, & Associates located at 1506 E. Dr. Martin L. King Blvd., Tampa, Florida may have received the UBR, however Mr. Ficarrota did not receive the UBR. Mr. Ficarrota was unaware the UBR had not been received and filed until he received the Application for Reinstatement.

Section 213(2)(2)(a) and (3), F.S., authorized the State of Florida to compromise liabilities for taxes and penalties. In regard to penalties [late fees] the taxpayer must show the noncompliance was due to reasonable cause. Since Mr. Ficarrota never received the UBR and was unaware that the UBR hadn't been filed until he received the Application for Reinstatement, we feel he had reasonable cause for failing to timely file the UBR. Accordingly, we are requesting the \$400 late fee be waived.

We have included the UBR and a check for the annual fee of \$150.00. Please contact me if you need additional information.
