### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### J. L. JUSTLINE, INC.

The undersigned subscriber (s) to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associates themselves together to form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

### ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this Corporation is:

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J. L. JUSTLINE, INC.

# ARTICLE II. - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- (a) To engage in Commercial and Residential Janitorial, Cleaning, Maintenance and light repairs Services.
- (b) To engage in the business of toasting, roasting, and packing services of coffee, whether in beans or ground, as well as the wholesale distribution, export and import of said products and all other related services both state and nationwide.
- (c) To engage in the buying and selling of any and all types of commercially traded products, within the United States or the purchasing and sales can be on a world wide activity and to engage in any and all other functions, services and/or ancillary, thereto, and to do all other things which may be desirable to achieve the purposes aforesaid and to operate a successful business.
- (d) To manufacture, purchase or otherwise acquire and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with goods, wares, merchandise, business and personal real estate property, and services of every class, kind and description.
- (e) To conduct business in, have one or more officers in, buy and hold mortgage, sell convey, lease or otherwise dispose of business and personal real estate property, including franchises, patent, copyrights, trademarks, and licenses in the State of Florida, and in all other states, districts, territories, countries and colonies.
- (f) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness and execute such mortgages, transfers, or corporate property or other instruments to secure payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- (g) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

- (h) To acquire by purchase, subscribers or otherwise, and to receive, hold, own, guarantee, sell, assign, exchange, underwrite, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of or deal in or with any of the shares of the capital stock or any voting trust certificates in respect of the shares of capital stock, scrip, warrants, rights, bonds, debentures, notes, trust receipts, and other securities, obligations, chooses in action and evidence of indebtedness or interest issued or created by any corporation, joint stock companies, syndicates, associations, firms, trusts or persons, public or private, or by the government, or by any state, territory, province, municipality or other political subdivision or by any governmental agency and as owner thereof to possess and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to execute consents and vote thereon and to do any and all acts and things necessary or advisable for the preservation, protection, improvements, and enhancement in value thereof.
- (i) In general, to carry on any other business in connection with foregoing, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the Laws of Florida upon, corporations formed under its Laws, and to do any or all things herein before set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.

# ARTICLE III. - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is:

One Thousand (1,000) shares Common Stock at \$ 1.00 Par Value.

All the aforementioned stock is to be issued as fully paid for an exempt from assessment. The capital stock may be paid for in money, property, labor or services, at a just valuation to be fixed by the incorporators or by the directors at a meeting called for such purposes.

# ARTICLE IV. - INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of capital with which this corporation shall begin business is not less than :

Five hundred (\$ 500.00) Dollars.

# ARTICLE V. - TERM OF EXISTANCE

This Corporation is to exist perpetually.

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# ARTICLE VII. - DIRECTORS

This Corporation shall have (3) Directors initially. The number of Directors may be increased from time to time on such manner as may be prescribed by the BY-LAWS, but shall never be less than one (1).

The Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless each person who shall serve at any time hereafter as a Director or Officer of the Corporation and any person who serves at the request of this Corporation, from and against any and all claims and liabilities to which such person shall become subject by reason of his having heretofore being as Director or Officer of the Corporation, or by reason of any action alleged to have been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by his as such Director or Officer, and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses reasonably incurred by him in connection with any such claim or liability provided that no person shall be indemnified against, or reimbursed for, any expense incurred in connection with any claim or liability as to which it shall be adjudged that such officer or director is liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duties.

The rights accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions shall not exclude any other right to which he may be lawfully entitled nor shall anything herein contained restrict the rights of the Corporation to indemnify, reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specially herein provided for.
